

ACCOUNTING

Accounting in Grade 10 to Grade 12 is no longer just writing up journals and posting to the ledgers but involves more understanding, analysis and interpretation of accounts and financial statements. It is not a learning subject as such but more a subject that requires the ability to think logically and the learner must be prepared to put in a lot of practice.

A learner selecting accounting as a subject should do so because the subject appeals to them, they enjoy a challenge and have a love for figures – not because chartered accountants earn good salaries or parents think it is a good choice.

Learners at St Dominic's must be aware that a minimum of 50% for EMS must be obtained at the end of Grade 9 for a learner to be allowed to take Accounting as a subject in Grade 10. As per IEB instructions given (Dec 2015) – all learners who choose to do Accounting in Grade 10 must also do Mathematics (not Maths Literacy).
